Pigs must be identified by ear notch on health certificate.

If you have your own 840 tags, you may tag those and record the numbers on your health certificate.

Health Requirements:

Animals do not have to be bled for PRV, but must have a health certificate with the following statement: **"No raw garbage, herd not under quarantine for any disease and uses no PRV vaccine."** Statement/suggestion to be on sale requirements to be issued to each consignor. It is suggested that all pigs be vaccinated for cirovirus, mycoplasma, erysipelas and swine influenza. Two injections given at least two weeks apart is preferred. This product is available commercially from several vaccine companies or veterinarians. This is not a sale requirement. If you have a premises ID number, please place it on health certificate.

Pigs may be unloaded at the fairgrounds the night before the sale.
